<u>Present law</u> defines "drug paraphernalia" and exempts rapid fentanyl test strips or any testing equipment or devices solely used, intended for use, or designed to determine whether a substance contains fentanyl or its analogues from the definition.

<u>Proposed law</u> expands the definition to include any testing equipment or devices solely used, intended for use, or designed to determine whether a substance contains any controlled dangerous substance or chemical compound that can cause physical harm or death.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.

- 2. Provide that an exempted device will be deemed drug paraphernalia if it is used to facilitate either the manufacture or distribution of controlled dangerous substances.
