Amendments proposed by Senate Committee on Insurance to Original Senate Bill No. 199

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 2, line 3, change "G." to "G. (1)"

3 AMENDMENT NO. 2

4 On page 2, line 4, change "(1)" to "(a)"

5 AMENDMENT NO. 3

6 On page 2, line 6, change "(2)" to "(b)"

7 AMENDMENT NO. 4

8 On page 2, between line 9 and line 10, insert the following:

9 "(2) "Business of insurance" does not include a person lawfully engaged in the
10 practice of law or lawfully assisting a patient with a prior authorization or
11 appeal concerning the denial of healthcare services provided by a duly licensed
12 healthcare provider."

13 AMENDMENT NO. 5

14 On page 2, delete lines 25 through 29 in their entirety and insert in lieu thereof the following:

15 "B. If the commissioner has received information or has reason to
16 believe that any person not licensed by the department has engaged or is
17 engaging in the business of insurance in this state and committed or is
18 committing any unfair trade practice as defined in this Code, the commissioner
19 may issue a cease and desist order, issue a fine, issue an order, or take any
20 other action against the person pursuant to R.S. 22:1961 et seq.

21 C. Any person not licensed by the commissioner who has been aggrieved
22 by any act, cease or desist order, fine, or order or any other action of the
23 commissioner pursuant to R.S. 22:1961 et seq. may appeal to any district court
24 for which venue is proper. The court shall conduct its review without a jury
25 and by trial de novo, except that if all parties, including the commissioner, so
26 stipulate, the review shall be confined to the record. Portions of the record may
27 be introduced by stipulation into evidence in a trial de novo as to those parties
28 so stipulating.

29 D. The filing of an appeal pursuant to this Section shall stay the
30 application of any cease and desist order, fine, order, or other action of the
31 commissioner to the appealing party unless the court, after giving the party
32 notice and an opportunity to be heard, determines that a stay would be
33 detrimental to the interest of the public."
