Abstract: Provides relative to preventing restaurant reservation fraud.

Proposed law defines "food service establishment" and "third-party restaurant reservation platform".

Proposed law provides for what a third-party restaurant reservation platform shall not do unless there is a written agreement between that third-party restaurant reservation platform and the food service establishment authorizing it to do so.

Proposed law provides that the attorney general may impose a civil penalty not to exceed \$1000 for each violation of proposed law. Proposed law provides that civil penalties collected under proposed law shall be used to promote consumer protection and education.

Proposed law provides that the attorney general may seek restitution to a person who purchased a reservation outlined in proposed law.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

The House Floor Amendments to the engrossed bill:

1. Provide that the attorney general may seek restitution.
