Purpose of the Bill: This bill requires the East Carroll Parish Sheriff's Office (ECPSO) to pay 100% of premium costs for group insurance for sheriffs and deputy sheriffs who retire directly from ECPSO on or after January 1, 2022, are eligible for Sheriff's Pension and Relief Fund benefits, and meet one of the following conditions upon retirement:

- 1. At least 62 years of age with 15+ years of total service credit, of which 12+ years must be with the ECPSO
- 2. At least 55 years of age with 20+ years of total service credit, of which 15+ years must be with the ECPSO
- 3. Any age with 30+ years of total service credit, of which 20+ years must be with the ECPSO
