Amendments proposed by Senator Boudreaux to Engrossed Senate Bill No. 57 by Senator Fesi

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, line 16, after "(ii)" and before "Any" insert "(aa)"

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, delete lines 8 and 9 in their entirety and insert "Government."

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 2, between lines 9 and 10 insert the following:

"(bb) Notwithstanding the provisions of Subitem (aa) of this Item, persons sixty-five years of age or older shall be prohibited from receiving the special assessment as provided in this Section if such person's or persons' adjusted gross income, as reported in the federal tax return for the year prior to the application for the special assessment, exceeds two hundred fifty thousand dollars. For persons applying for the special assessment whose filing status is married filing separately, the adjusted gross income for purposes of this Section shall be determined by combining the adjusted gross income on both federal tax returns. Beginning for the tax year 2027, and for each tax year thereafter, the two hundred fifty thousand dollar limit shall be adjusted annually by the Consumer Price Index as reported by the United States Government."
