7	Section 1. R.S. 17:8.9(A)(1) is hereby amended and reenacted and R.S. 17:8.9(A)(6)

11	A.(1) Beginning January 1, 2025, any Any applicant for an initial educator
12	credential or teaching authorization issued by the State Board of Elementary and
13	Secondary Education through the state Department of Education shall undergo a
14	criminal history record check as provided in this Section.

16	(6) An early childhood ancillary certificate as provided for in rules and
17	regulations promulgated by the State Board of Elementary and Secondary Education

- 4 Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
- 5 signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature
- 6 by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If
- 7 vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become
- 8 effective on the day following such approval.

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Larvadain

Abstract: Provides exception for second criminal history check for certain early childhood workers.

<u>Present law</u> (R.S. 15:587.1(C) and R.S. 17:407.42 and 407.71) requires criminal history checks for employment purposes. <u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u>.

<u>Present law</u> (R.S. 17:8.9) requires criminal history checks for certain credentials and authorization issued by the State Board of Elementary and Secondary Education through the state Dept. of Education. <u>Proposed law</u> excepts an early childhood ancillary certificate from requiring a criminal history check.

Effective upon signature of governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.

(Amends R.S. 17:8.9(A)(1); Adds R.S. 17:8.9(A)(6))

Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

The Committee Amendments Proposed by <u>House Committee on Education</u> to the original bill:

1. Remove references to an educator credential and teaching authorization.
