Abstract: Prohibits the production, manufacture, distribution, or possession of products containing the hallucinogenic chemicals beta-phenyl-GABA, muscimol, or ibotenic acid and any analogue thereof.

<u>Proposed law</u> creates the crime of producing, manufacturing, distributing, or possessing with intent to produce, manufacture, or distribute products intended for human consumption that contain betaphenyl-GABA, muscimol, ibotenic acid, or any analogue thereof.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides a penalty of two to 10 years imprisonment with or without hard labor, or a fine of not more than \$20,000, or both for a conviction of producing, manufacturing, distributing, or possessing with intent to do so.

<u>Proposed law</u> creates the crime of possession of products intended for human consumption that contains beta-phenyl-GABA, muscimol, ibotenic acid, or any analogue thereof.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides a penalty of not more than five years imprisonment with or without hard labor, or a fine of not more than \$5,000, or both for a conviction of possession.
