4	WHEREAS, in 2025, Food & Wine magazine named Cure as the top bar in the
5	United States; and
6	WHEREAS, New Orleans has long been regarded as the "cradle of cocktail
7	civilization" and the city has a rich legacy of mixology, tradition, and innovation that spans
8	centuries; and
9	WHEREAS, in the wake of Hurricane Katrina in 2005, the people of New Orleans
10	demonstrated unparalleled resilience while individuals and businesses alike worked together
11	to rebuild and reimagine the city's future; and
12	WHEREAS, in 2009, Cure founders, Neal Bodenheimer and Matthew Kohnke,
13	transformed a historic, turn-of-the-century firehouse on Freret Street into New Orleans' first
14	stand alone craft cocktail bar and ignited a modern movement in a city deeply rooted in
15	cocktail history; and
16	WHEREAS, Cure has served as a symbol of New Orleans' rebirth and progress,
17	bridging the city's storied cocktail traditions with forward-thinking innovation and providing

5	Sazerac, as well as its original creations such as the Gunshop Fizz and seasonal cocktails like
6	the Girl Dinner, all of which highlight both local ingredients and artistic presentation; and
7	WHEREAS, the bar's commitment to honoring both past and present is evident in its
8	diverse menu, which has evolved over the years to reflect changing tastes, industry trends,
9	and a growing emphasis on zero-proof drink options; and
10	WHEREAS, Cure remains a vital cultural and economic force in the Freret Street
11	corridor and continues to showcase New Orleans' ability to rebuild, reinvent, and lead while
12	celebrating the city's traditions and community spirit; and
13	WHEREAS, Cure and its team embody the dual role of "innovators and keepers of
14	the flame" carrying forward the cocktail legacy of New Orleans while setting a national
15	standard for excellence in hospitality.
