18	forces of the United States. As used in this Subsection, "armed forces of the United
19	States" means persons serving or who have served in the United States Army, Navy,
20	Air Force, Space Force, Marines, and Coast Guard, reservists, and members of the
21	National Guard. The plate issued under this Section shall not be transferable between
22	motor vehicle owners. In the event the owner of a motor vehicle issued a "Blue Star
23	Mothers" plate should sell, trade, exchange, or otherwise dispose of such vehicle, the
24	plate shall be retained by original applicant to whom the plate was issued.

Abstract: Adds the U.S. Space Force to various statutory definitions of U.S. Armed Forces.

<u>Present law</u> provides, with respect to various provisions in <u>present law</u>, for definitions of "veteran", "disabled veteran", "active member of the United States Armed Forces", "uniformed service", "military", "military medical personnel", "activated military person", and "honorary discharged military person", each of which include former or current members of the U.S. Armed Forces.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and adds the U.S. Space Force to various statutory definitions which include the U.S. Armed Forces.
