CONDOLENCES. Expresses sincere and heartfelt condolences to the family and friends of Harry Heil Roberts, PhD, on the occasion of his passing.

1	A RESOLUTION
2	To express the sincere condolences of the Senate of the Legislature of Louisiana upon the
3	passing of Dr. Harry Heil Roberts, Boyd Professor Emeritus of Louisiana State
4	University, and to recognize his distinguished contributions to the fields of marine
5	geology and oceanography, as well as his lasting impact on higher education and
6	scientific advancement in the state of Louisiana and beyond.
7	WHEREAS, it is with deep regret and profound respect that the Senate has learned
8	of the passing of Dr. Harry Heil Roberts, PhD, on March 26, 2025, at the age of eighty-five;
9	and
10	WHEREAS, Dr. Roberts was born on February 2, 1940, in Huntington, West
11	Virginia, and raised in Milton, where he excelled both academically and athletically,
12	graduating from Milton High School in 1958 and earning his Bachelor of Science in Physics
13	from Marshall University in 1963, where he also played point guard for the Thundering Herd
14	basketball team; and
15	WHEREAS, he continued his academic pursuits at Louisiana State University, where
16	he earned his Master of Science in Geology in 1966 and his PhD in Geology in 1969, thus
17	beginning a remarkable career spanning over five decades in marine geology and
18	oceanography; and

1	WHEREAS, Dr. Roberts dedicated his professional life to Louisiana State
2	University's Coastal Studies Institute, rising from instructor to director and ultimately
3	earning the university's highest academic honor when he was named a Boyd Professor in
4	2001 and Boyd Professor Emeritus in 2006; and
5	WHEREAS, he made groundbreaking contributions to the scientific understanding
6	of the Gulf of Mexico, including the discovery and direct observation of frozen methane
7	hydrates, the mapping of the seafloor, and research into deltaic dynamics, sedimentation, and
8	coastal sustainability; and
9	WHEREAS, his prolific scholarly output includes over 200 peer-reviewed
10	publications and numerous professional honors, including the prestigious Shephard's Medal
11	in 2003 for sustained excellence in marine geology, as well as fellowships from the
12	Geological Society of America, the American Association for the Advancement of Science,
13	and the National Science Foundation; and
14	WHEREAS, Dr. Roberts received numerous additional accolades throughout his
15	career, including the Doris Malkin Curtis Medal, the Grover Murray Best Published Paper
16	Award, the Distinguished Research Master Award, and the Joe and Richard Lipsey
17	Professional Educators Award, among others; and
18	WHEREAS, he also served as an editor for major scientific journals, mentored
19	generations of marine geologists, and earned the admiration of colleagues and students alike
20	for his dedication, insight, and generous spirit; and
21	WHEREAS, beyond his professional accomplishments, Dr. Roberts was a devoted
22	family man who lovingly supported his son, Andrew Roberts, M.D., and daughter-in-law,
23	Maryna Roberts, and was a tireless caretaker to his late wife, Mary Sue Roberts; and
24	WHEREAS, Dr. Roberts will be remembered not only for his transformative
25	scientific work, but also for his kindness, humility, deep curiosity, and the selfless generosity
26	with which he served his family, students, and community.
27	THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Senate of the Legislature of Louisiana
28	does hereby express its deepest condolences upon the passing of Dr. Harry Heil Roberts,

- 29 commends his legacy of academic excellence and scientific discovery, and recognizes the
- 30 profound impact of his life's work on the state of Louisiana, the nation, and the world.
