DISTRICTS/ECONOMIC DEVEL: Provides relative to the Gentilly Development District
in Orleans Parish

1 AN ACT

2 To amend and reenact R.S. 33:2740.70(B), relative to Orleans Parish; to provide relative to
3 the Gentilly Development District; to provide relative to the boundaries of the
4 district; to provide for an effective date; and to provide for related matters.

5 Notice of intention to introduce this Act has been published
6 as provided by Article III, Section 13 of the Constitution of
7 Louisiana.

8 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

9 Section 1. R.S. 33:2740.70(B) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:
10 §2740.70. The Gentilly Development District; creation, composition, and powers;
11 levy of ad valorem taxes and issuance of bonds

12 * * *

13 B.(1) The boundaries of the district shall encompass the area included within
14 the following perimeter: Beginning at the intersection of Bayou St. John and ~~Robert~~
15 ~~E. Lee Boulevard~~ Allen Toussaint Boulevard; then following ~~Robert E. Lee~~
16 ~~Boulevard~~ Allen Toussaint Boulevard to its intersection with Leon C. Simon
17 Boulevard; then Leon C. Simon Boulevard to its intersection with the Industrial
18 Canal; then along the Industrial Canal to its intersection with I-10; then along I-10
19 to its intersection with I-610; then along I-610 to Bayou St. John; then Bayou St.
20 John to the point of beginning.

(2) In addition to the provisions of Paragraph (1) of this Subsection, the boundaries of the district shall also include the area included within the following perimeter: I-10 to the west, I-10 and I-610 to the north, Peoples Avenue south to Almonaster Avenue to the east, and Florida Avenue to the south.

6 Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
7 signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature
8 by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If
9 vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become
10 effective on the day following such approval.

Abstract: Relative to the Gentilly Development District, expands the boundaries of the district.

Present law creates the Gentilly Development District as a political subdivision in Orleans Parish. Provides that the district is governed by a seven-member board of commissioners. Provides for district boundaries and powers and duties.

Proposed law retains present law but expands the boundaries of the district.

Effective upon signature of governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
