HOUSE COMMITTEE AMENDMENTS

2025 Regular Session

Amendments proposed by House Committee on Municipal, Parochial and Cultural Affairs to Original House Bill No. 86 by Representative McMakin

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 4, after "commission;" and before "to provide" delete "to decrease the commission's membership;"

4 AMENDMENT NO. 2

5 On page 1, delete lines 13 through 20 in their entirety and on page 2, delete lines 1 and 2 in 6 their entirety and on line 3, delete "<u>George, and Zachary</u>. The members shall serve during 7 their terms of office." and insert the following:

8 "and six four appointed members for a total of nine commissioners. The ex officio 9 members shall be the mayor-president, or an officer or employee of the city or parish 10 designated by the mayor-president from time to time; a member of the school board 11 of East Baton Rouge Parish, designated by the school board for a term coincident 12 with his term on the school board; and a member of the planning commission 13 designated by the planning commission for a term coincident with his term on the 14 planning commission. mayors of the following municipalities: Baker, Baton Rouge, 15 Central, St. George, and Zachary. Each mayor may designate a person to serve in his place as a member of the commission. Each designee shall serve at the pleasure 16 17 of the designating mayor. The ex officio members shall serve during their terms of 18 office. The six four appointed members shall be qualified voters of the parish 19 appointed by the metropolitan council governing authority of the city of Baton Rouge, parish of East Baton Rouge for terms of three years. Of the four appointed 20 21 members, at least two shall be residents of the city of Baton Rouge, and at least one 22 shall be a resident of the unincorporated area of East Baton Rouge Parish. Following 23 the release of each decennial federal census, the commission may, by majority vote, 24 reallocate these designated residency requirements to reflect the changes in 25 population distribution across the parish. Any such reallocation shall apply prospectively and shall not alter the term of any sitting member. Vacancies shall be 26 27 filled by the designating or appointing body for the unexpired portion of the term authority." 28

29 AMENDMENT NO. 3

30 On page 2, line 7, change "<u>Three</u>" to "<u>Five</u>"
