Abstract: Requires public schools to offer a mental health assessment to certain students at the beginning of each school year.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires public schools to make available to each student the opportunity to undergo a mental health assessment by a licensed behavioral health provider within the first 90 days of each school year. Requires the consent of his parent or legal guardian. Applies to students in grades three through 12.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires the La. Dept. of Health (LDH) to provide to each public school a list of licensed behavioral health providers. Provides that, for the purposes of <u>proposed law</u>, such provider means one of the following:

- (1) A provider approved by LDH to provide behavioral health services and who is property credentialed by an accrediting body.
- (2) An individual provider whis licensed and authorized to conduct mental health assessments.

<u>Proposed law</u> authorizes each public school principal to use his discretion in establishing a time and location to conduct the assessments.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

The Committee Amendments Proposed by House Committee on Education to the original bill:

- 1. Change lowest grade of student to which assessment is made available <u>from</u> fourth <u>to</u> third.
- 2. Require the assessments be done at no cost to local, parish, and other public school boards.
- 3. Authorize each public school principal to use his discretion in establishing a time and location to conduct the assessments.
