SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 30

SPECIAL DAY/WEEK/MONTH. Designates May 17-24, 2025, as Safe Boating Week in Louisiana.

1	A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION
2	To designate May 17-24, 2025, as Safe Boating Week in Louisiana.
3	WHEREAS, the Federal Boat Safety Act of 1971 created a partnership between the
4	federal government and the states to improve the safety of recreational boating; and
5	WHEREAS, in recognition of the importance of safe boating practices, the United
6	States Congress by joint resolution approved on June 4, 1958, and enacted 36 U.S.C. 131,
7	as amended, authorized and requested the president of the United States to proclaim annually
8	the seven-day period before Memorial Day weekend as "National Safe Boating Week"; and
9	WHEREAS, the United States has nearly twelve million registered recreational boats
10	and over three hundred thousand of those boats are located on Louisiana waters; and
11	WHEREAS, while fishing, sailing, or otherwise enjoying Louisiana's beautiful
12	waterways with family or friends, it is essential that operators follow safe boating practices
13	for everyone's protection; and
14	WHEREAS, Louisiana encourages all citizens to institute safe boating practices
15	necessary to enjoy Louisiana's waters responsibly by taking the necessary steps to reduce
16	injuries and fatalities; and
17	WHEREAS, the United States Coast Guard considers the use of engine cut-off
18	switches to be important to protect operators of powerboats who become ejected or fall

overboard since without such a feature the boat will typically continue to operate until it runs
out of fuel, runs aground, or collides with another boat or object; and
WHEREAS, the vast majority of boating incidents are caused by human error or poor
judgment and not caused by the boat, equipment, or environmental factors; and
WHEREAS, U.S. Coast Guard statistics show that drowning was the reported cause
of death in 76 percent of recreational boating fatalities in 2023, and that 85 percent of those
who drowned were not wearing life jackets; and
WHEREAS, while boats are a marvelous source of recreation, unknowledgeable boat
operators are a risk to other boaters when they do not know or obey the navigation rules of
the road, drink alcohol or take drugs while operating a boat, or choose not to wear a life
jacket; and
WHEREAS, boating knowledge and skills are important in reducing human error and
improving judgment; if people are aware of the risk, they are more likely to take the
precautionary measures to protect themselves, their friends, family, and others, and highlight
the importance of spreading the message of boating safety education in our state.
THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby
designate May 17-24, 2025, as Safe Boating Week in Louisiana.
