 32 37:3562, and providing. Each licensed massage therapist shall provide evidence that the
 33 licensee has completed <u>of the completion of</u> continuing education requirements, as
 34 established by rule of the board.

35 (2)(a) Beginning with the renewal cycle of April 1, 2022, any excess continuing 36 education credits may be applied to the following year only after a licensee has satisfied the 37 license renewal requirements.

- (b)(i) The board may shall require any renewing applicant licensed prior to April 1, 2022, who has not previously submitted to submit to a state and federal background check as described in R.S. 37:3555(A)(14) with the board, to submit to such background check prior to the license being renewed.
- (ii) The board shall require any renewing applicant registered prior to August 1, 2025, who has not previously submitted to a state and federal background check as described in R.S. 37:3555(A)(14) with the board, to submit to such background check prior to the registration being renewed.
- 9 (iii) In order to renew, an applicant shall not have pled guilty to or been convicted 10 of any sex-related crime, crime of violence, or crime related to the practice of massage therapy."
