Proposed law requires that if the Legislative Fiscal Office (LFO) determines a rule has a fiscal or economic impact greater than \$200,000 per year or more than \$600,000 over three years, the rule shall not take effect unless the appropriate House and Senate subject matter committee approves the rule, the committee fails to meet for the purpose of making a determination, or the governor approves the final promulgation of the rule in writing.

Proposed law requires the appropriate House and Senate subject matter committees to approve rules in which the Legislative Fiscal Office determines a fiscal or economic impact of greater than \$200,000 per year or more than \$600,000 over three years. The Office of the State Register and the Legislative Fiscal Office can absorb any increased workload associated with proposed law.

Should proposed law result in additional official committee meetings, legislative members may earn per diem and mileage reimbursements (\$178 per day and \$0.70 per mile respectively).
