HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES: Creates a study committee to research office space for members of the House of Representatives

A RESOLUTION

2	To create a study committee to study the feasibility of providing office space for members
3	of the House of Representatives in the state capitol or other state buildings.
4	WHEREAS, meeting with a state legislator is an effective way for constituents,
5	advocates, and other concerned Louisiana residents to convey a message about a specific
6	legislative issue; and
7	WHEREAS, over half of the country's states provide offices within their capitol
8	buildings for state representatives and senators; and
9	WHEREAS, most state representatives in Louisiana do not currently have offices
10	within the capitol complex, so there is not a central location for constituents to meet with
11	these legislators and advocate their needs; and
12	WHEREAS, many members of the legislature have determined that there is a need
13	for office space for all legislators at the capitol.
14	THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the House of Representatives of the
15	Legislature of Louisiana does hereby create a study committee, composed of nine members
16	as hereinafter provided, to study the feasability of providing office space for members of the
17	House of Representatives in the state capitol or other state buildings.
18	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the study committee created herein shall be
19	composed of:

- 1 Nine members of the House of Representatives of the Legislature of Louisiana,
- 2 appointed by the speaker. Four of the nine members shall be freshman members of the
- 3 House of Representatives of the Legislature of Louisiana.
- 4 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the study committee shall meet as necessary and
- 5 shall report its findings to the House of Representatives prior to the convening of the 2026
- 6 Regular Session of the Legislature of Louisiana.
