15	A. Notwithstanding any other provision of this Chapter, a provider that
16	charges a fee for the provision of earned wage access services, including transaction
17	fees, membership fees, or any other form of compensation, shall submit an annual
18	report to the Office of Financial Institutions. The report shall include the following
19	information for the preceding calendar year:
20	(1) The total number of Louisiana consumers served.
21	(2) A description of each type of fee charged and the average amount charged
22	per transaction or per user.
23	(3) The number and total value of wage access transactions processed.
24	(4) The number and nature of consumer complaints received and the
25	resolution status of each complaint.
26	(5) A statement affirming compliance with the requirement to offer a no-cost
27	option for access to proceeds.
28	B. The Office of Financial Institutions shall make this data available to the
29	public in aggregated form in an annual report assessing the impact of earned wage
30	access services in the state."
