

HOUSE COMMITTEE AMENDMENTS

2025 Regular Session

Amendments proposed by House Committee on Administration of Criminal Justice to Engrossed Senate Bill No. 22 by Senator Hodges

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, line 2, after "enact" and before the comma "," delete "R.S. 14:67.24" and insert "R.S. 14:61(B)(1) and 67.24"

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 1, line 5, after "Section 1." and before "hereby" delete "R.S. 14:67.24 is" and insert "R.S. 14:61(B)(1) and 67.24 are"

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 1, between lines 5 and 6, insert the following:

"§61. Unauthorized entry of a critical infrastructure

* * *

B. For the purposes of this Section, the following words shall have the following meanings:

(1)(a) "Critical infrastructure" means any and all structures, sites, equipment, or other immovable or movable property located within or upon any of the following:

(i) ~~chemical~~ Chemical plants or facilities, manufacturing facilities, or refineries;

(ii) ~~electrical~~ Electrical power generating facilities, electrical transmission substations and distribution substations;

(ii) ~~water~~ Water intake structures and water treatment facilities;

(iii) ~~natural~~ Natural gas transmission compressor stations, liquefied natural gas (LNG) terminals and storage facilities, natural gas and hydrocarbon storage facilities;

(iv) ~~transportation~~ Transportation facilities, such as ports, railroad switching yards, pipelines, and trucking terminals;

(v) ~~water~~ Water control structures including floodgates or pump stations;

(vi) ~~wireline~~ Wireline and wireless communications and data network internet facilities; and any equipment or communication wires that are connected or appurtenant to the facilities, including but not limited to broadcast television equipment, video equipment, fiber optics, and any lines or wires that are used for transmission from the facilities.

(b) or "Critical infrastructure" shall include any site where the construction or improvement of any facility or structure referenced in this Section is occurring.
