ENVIRONMENT/ENFORCEMENT

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Provides for the maximum civil penalty for citations issued through the expedited enforcement program

Proposed law increases the expedited enforcement threshold for the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) for minor and moderate assessment payments due to violations of the enforcement statute. Current law states that if a single assessment is less than \$3,000 or an aggregate total of less than \$5,000, that entity can utilize the expedited enforcement program. Proposed law increases these thresholds from \$5,000 to \$10,000 respectively.
