Abstract: Adds members to the board of commissioners for the East Baton Rouge Parish Communications District.

Present law generally provides that communication districts are governed by a board composed of seven members appointed by the parish governing authority. Requires members to be qualified electors of the district. Provides that members serve four-year staggered terms.

Proposed law provides that the East Baton Rouge Parish Communications District shall be governed by a board of commissioners composed of nine members. Provides that the two members added by proposed law shall be appointed by the governing authority of East Baton Rouge Parish. Provides that the two members added by proposed law shall serve initial terms of four years each, and their successors shall serve four-year terms.

1. Remove requirement that one of the members added to the board be a qualified elector of the city of St. George.
