### 1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

- 2 On page 1, line 3, change "3591.6," to "3591.7,"

- On page 1, line 7, after "data;" and before "and" insert "to provide for enforcement;" 4

- On page 6, between lines 14 and 15, insert the following: 8

### 9 "(8) Advertise, print, display, publish, distribute, broadcast or cause to be 10 advertised, printed, displayed, published, distributed, or broadcasted, in any manner, any statement or representation with regard to the earned wage access services 11 offered by the provider that does either of the following: 12 13 (a) Is false, misleading, or deceptive. 14 (b) Omits material information that is necessary to make the statement or 15 representation not false, misleading, or deceptive."

AMENDMENT NO. 5 16

17 On page 6, line 26, after "Institutions.", delete the remainder of the line and delete lines 27 18 and 28 in their entirety and insert in lieu thereof the following:

19 "The report shall pertain to the preceding calendar year and shall be submitted no later than March first of the following year. All reports shall include the following information: 20 21

- (1) Gross revenue attributable to its earned wage access services.
- 22 (2) The total number of transactions in which the provider provided proceeds 23 to consumers. (3) The total number of unique consumers to whom the provider provided 24 25 proceeds. (4) The total dollar amount of proceeds the provider provided to consumers. 26 (5) The total dollar amount of fees, voluntary tips, gratuities, or other 27 28 donations the provider received from consumers. 29 (6) The number and nature of consumer complaints received by the provider 30 and the resolution status of each complaint."
- 31 AMENDMENT NO. 6
- 32 On page 7, delete lines 1 through 10 in their entirety and insert in lieu thereof the following:

1	"B. The Office of Financial Institutions shall make this data available to the
2	public in aggregated form in an annual report assessing the impact of earned wage
3	access services in the state by July first of each year.
4	C. Submission by providers of the annual report in Subsection A shall not be
5	deemed an action or transaction subject to the jurisdiction of the Office of Financial
6	Institutions.
7	§3591.7. Enforcement of this Chapter; penalties
8	A. Providers subject to the provisions of this Chapter shall be subject to
9	enforcement by the attorney general pursuant to the provisions of the Unfair Trade
10	Practices and Consumer Protection Law, R.S. 51:1401 et seq.
11	B. Any provider that fails to timely submit the required annual report as
12	required by R.S. 51:3591.6 shall not be authorized to utilize the provisions of this
13	Chapter.
14	C. If a provider fails to timely submit the annual report required by R.S.
15	51:3591.6, any agreement made by that provider with a consumer for
16	consumer-directed earned wage access services, credit agreements, promissory notes,
17	or other contracts with a consumer shall be an absolute nullity.
18	Section 2. The first report required by R.S. 51:3591.6 as enacted by Section 1 of this
19	Act shall be filed with the Office of Financial Institutions no later than March 1, 2027."
