17	"(7) If an underground utility or facility is damaged during excavation or
18	demolition, the excavator or demolisher shall submit a written incident report to the
19	Regional Notification Center and the affected facility owner within seventy-two
20	hours of the incident. The report shall include all of the following:
21	(a) The date and time of the incident.
22	(b) A description of the damage.
23	(c) Any immediate actions taken.
24	(d) Photographs, if available."

25 AMENDMENT NO. 6

26 On page 3, after line 11, add the following:

27	"§1749.16. Precautions to avoid damage
28	In addition to the notification requirements in R.S. 40:1749.13 and 1749.14
29	and the emergency notification requirements in R.S. 40:1749.15, each person
30	responsible for an excavation or demolition operation shall do the following:

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1	(5) For excavation or demolition projects occurring in areas designated by
2	the office of broadband development and connectivity or the Louisiana Department
3	of Transportation as high-risk for underground utility congestion, the excavator shall
4	be required to consult and incorporate any available utility mapping data into its
5	project plan prior to commencing work."
