A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

To commend Danny Granger on being inducted into the 2025 class of the Louisiana Sports Hall of Fame.

WHEREAS, Danny Granger was born on April 20, 1983, in New Orleans, Louisiana, and is a proud graduate of Grace King High School; and

WHEREAS, Granger played collegiate basketball at Bradley University and the University of New Mexico, where he compiled career averages of 16.7 points and 8.2 rebounds per game; and

WHEREAS, in his senior season (2004–2005), Granger was the only player in National Collegiate Athletic Association (NCAA) Division I basketball to average at least 18.8 points and 8.9 rebounds per game, which distinguished him as one of the most complete and dominant players in the college game; and

WHEREAS, Granger was selected seventeenth overall in the first round of the 2005 National Basketball Association (NBA) Draft by the Indiana Pacers and he went on to play ten seasons in the NBA, including eight and one-half seasons with the Pacers, followed by playing with the Los Angeles Clippers and the Miami Heat; and

WHEREAS, during his NBA career, Granger played in five hundred eighty-six games, started in four hundred twenty-five of them, and maintained career averages of 16.8
