7	through extra innings to defeat No. 4 St. Amant 5-3, in a thrilling semifinal showdown that

9	WHEREAS, facing elimination in the bottom of the seventh inning, Kailyn Mire
10	delivered a clutch two-run home run to tie the game, followed by Kallie England, who
11	launched a go-ahead two-run homer in the bottom of the eighth to seal the win and propel
12	the Lady Broncos into the championship game; and
13	WHEREAS, on May 4, 2025, the Lady Broncos completed their championship quest
14	with a heart-pounding 3-2 victory over No. 3 Dutchtown in the title game, showcasing grit,
15	determination, and championship-caliber execution; and

17	that secured the winning run and clinched Sam Houston High School's first state title since
