Policy 19 20 A. The legislature finds and declares that persons in this state who 21 seek a place to live should be able to find such housing whenever it is 22 available. Further, in many localities there may be housing shortages. All 23 persons should therefore be able to compete for available housing on an open, fair, and equitable basis, regardless of race, color, religion, sex, 24 disability, familial status, national origin, military status or natural, 25 26 protective, or cultural hairstyle. 27 28 §2603. Definitions 29 As used in this Chapter: 30 31 32 (10) "Military status" means status as: 33 (a) A member of the uniformed forces, as defined in 10 U.S.C. § 34 101(A)(5), of the United States or a reserve component thereof named 35 under 10 U.S.C. § 10101. 36 (b) A dependent as defined in 50 U.S.C. § 3911(4) except that the 37 support provided by the service member to the individual shall have been provided one hundred eighty days immediately preceding an 38 39 alleged action that if proven true would constitute unlawful

2	immediately preceding an application for relief under 50 U.S.C. Chapter

4	(10) (11) "Natural, protective, or cultural hairstyle" shall include but
5	is not limited to afros, dreadlocks, twists, locs, braids, cornrow braids, Bantu
6	knots, curls, and hair styled to protect hair texture or for cultural significance.
7	(11) (12) "Person" includes one or more individuals, corporations,
8	partnerships, associations, labor organizations, legal representatives, mutual
9	companies, joint stock companies, trusts, unincorporated organizations,
10	trustees, trustees in bankruptcy, receivers, and fiduciaries.
11	(12) (13) "Respondent" means the person or other entity accused in
12	a complaint of a discriminatory housing practice, or, any other person or
13	entity identified in the course of an investigation and notified that they are a
14	respondent who shall be joined in the complaint.
15	(13) (14) "To rent" includes to lease, to sublease, to let, and otherwise
16	to grant for a consideration the right to occupy premises owned by the
17	occupant.

20	AMENDMENT NO. 6
21	On page 7, after line 17, insert the following:
22	"§2607. Discrimination in residential real estate related transactions
23	A. It is unlawful for any person or other entity whose business
24	includes engaging in residential real estate related transactions to
25	discriminate against any person in making available such a transaction, or in
26	the terms or conditions of such a transaction, because of race, color, religion,
27	sex, disability, familial status, national origin, military status, or natural,
28	protective, or cultural hairstyle.

30	C. Nothing in this Chapter prohibits a person engaged in the business
31	of furnishing appraisals of real property to take into consideration factors
32	other than race, color, religion, national origin, sex, disability, military
33	status or familial status.
34	\$2608 Disarimination in provision of brokers as sarvings
35	§2608. Discrimination in provision of brokerage services It is unlawful to deny any person access to or membership or
36	participation in any multiple-listing service, real estate brokers' organization
37	or other service, organization, or facility relating to the business of selling or
38	renting dwellings, or to discriminate against him in the terms or conditions
39	of such access, membership, or participation, on account of race, color,
40	religion, sex, disability, familial status, national origin, military status or
41	natural, protective, or cultural hairstyle."
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
