2	To amend and R.S. 11:921, 924(2) and (5), 925, 927(B)(2)(b)(introductory paragraph), (c),
3	(d), and (e) and (3)(a) and (b), 928, 931, and 932(B), (C), and (D), to enact R.S.
4	11:721.1(D), 822(A)(11), 932(E), and 933, and to repeal R.S. 11:927(B)(2)(f),
5	relative to the Teachers' Retirement System of Louisiana; to provide for optional
6	participation in the regular retirement plan; to provide for membership on the board
7	of trustees; to provide for the expansion of participation in the optional retirement
8	plan; to provide for eligibility; to provide relative to employer contributions; to
9	provide for implementation; to provide relative to transferring from the optional
10	retirement plan to the regular retirement plan; to provide for an Optional Retirement
11	Plan Advisory Committee; to provide an effective date; and to provide for related
12	matters.
13	Notice of intention to introduce this Act has been published
14	as provided by Article X, Section 29(C) of the Constitution
15	of Louisiana.
16	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
17	Section 1. R.S. 11:921, 924(2) and (5), 925, 927(B)(2)(b)(introductory paragraph),
18	(c), (d), and (e) and (3)(a) and (b), 928, 931, and 932(B), (C), and (D) are hereby amended
19	and reenacted and R.S. 11:721.1(D), 822(A)(11), 932(E), and 933 are hereby enacted to read
20	as follows:

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1	§721.1. Option to participate in system
2	* * *
3	D.(1) Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary,
4	membership is optional for each person who is sixty years of age or older at the time
5	of first employment in a position covered by the Teachers' Retirement System of
6	Louisiana and for each person who is fifty-five years of age or older who has credit
7	for at least forty quarters in the Social Security system at the time of first
8	employment in a position covered by the Teachers' Retirement System of Louisiana.
9	(2) The provisions of Paragraph (1) of this Subsection shall not apply to
10	rehired retirees.

12	§822. Members of board of trustees; appointment or election; terms of office;
13	vacancies; compensation
14	A. The board shall consist of such trustees as follows:
15	* * *
16	(11) The commissioner of higher education, ex officio, or his designee.
17	* * *
18	§921. Creation of plan
19	A. There is established an optional retirement plan for the following classes
20	of employees covered by this Subpart who are eligible for membership in the
21	Teachers' Retirement System of Louisiana:
22	(1) The academic and administrative employees of public <u>postsecondary</u>
23	education institutions of higher education.
24	(2) The employees of the Board of Regents, Board of Trustees Supervisors
25	for State Colleges and Universities the University of Louisiana System, Board of
26	Supervisors of Louisiana State University and Agricultural and Mechanical College,
27	and Board of Supervisors of Southern University and Agricultural and Mechanical
28	College, and Board of Supervisors of Community and Technical Colleges, or their
29	successors, and any other constitutionally established board which manages public
30	postsecondary education institutions of higher education.

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1	B. Any person covered by the provisions of Paragraph $A(2)$ Paragraph (A)(2)
2	of this Section shall be required to pay the annual actuarial cost of participating in
3	the optional retirement plan.

5	§924. Criteria for placement of contracts
6	The Board of Trustees of the Teachers' Retirement System of Louisiana shall
7	select no more than three companies from which contracts will be purchased. In
8	setting the criteria for this selection, the board shall consider, among other things, the
9	following:

11	(2) The efficacy of the contracts in the recruitment and retention of
12	employees for the various state public postsecondary education institutions of higher
13	education and for the Board of Regents, Board of Trustees Supervisors for State
14	Colleges and Universities the University of Louisiana System, Board of Supervisors
15	of Louisiana State University and Agricultural and Mechanical College, and Board
16	of Supervisors of Southern University and Agricultural and Mechanical College, <u>and</u>
17	Board of Supervisors of Community and Technical Colleges, or their successors, and
18	any other constitutionally established board which manages public postsecondary
19	education institutions of higher education.
20	* * *
21	(5) The suitability of the rights and benefits to the needs and interests of
22	participating employees and the various state public postsecondary education
23	institutions of higher education and the Board of Regents, Board of Trustees
24	Supervisors for State Colleges and Universities the University of Louisiana System,
25	Board of Supervisors of Louisiana State University and Agricultural and Mechanical
26	College, and Board of Supervisors of Southern University and Agricultural and
27	Mechanical College, and Board of Supervisors of Community and Technical
28	Colleges, or their successors, and any other constitutionally established board which
29	manages public postsecondary education institutions of higher education.

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§925. Eligibility

2 Academic and administrative employees of public postsecondary A. 3 education institutions of higher education and employees of the Board of Regents, 4 Board of Trustees Supervisors for State Colleges and Universities the University of Louisiana System, Board of Supervisors of Louisiana State University and 5 6 Agricultural and Mechanical College, and Board of Supervisors of Southern 7 University and Agricultural and Mechanical College, and Board of Supervisors of 8 Community and Technical Colleges or their successors, and any other 9 constitutionally established board which manages public postsecondary education 10 institutions of higher education who are current members in the regular retirement 11 plan of the Teachers' Retirement System of Louisiana may make an irrevocable 12 election to participate in the optional retirement plan within one hundred eighty days 13 after the implementation date of the optional retirement plan at their employer 14 institution or board. Eligible employees who are initially employed on or after the 15 implementation date at their employer institution or board may make an irrevocable 16 election to participate in the optional retirement plan within sixty days after their 17 employment date. Any academic or administrative employee of a public 18 postsecondary education institution of higher education or employee of the Board of 19 Regents, Board of Trustees Supervisors for State Colleges and Universities the 20 University of Louisiana System, Board of Supervisors of Louisiana State University 21 and Agricultural and Mechanical College, or Board of Supervisors of Southern 22 University and Agricultural and Mechanical College, or Board of Supervisors of 23 Community and Technical Colleges, or their successors, and any other 24 constitutionally established board which manages public postsecondary education 25 institutions of higher education who is not eligible for membership in the Teachers' 26 Retirement System of Louisiana because of age shall be eligible to participate in the 27 optional retirement plan upon election by such employee. Elections must be made 28 in writing and filed with the appropriate officer of the employer institution or board, 29 who shall forward a copy of the completed election to the Teachers' Retirement System of Louisiana. Current Teachers' Retirement System of Louisiana members' 30

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elections will be effective as of the date they are filed. Elections of eligible employees hired on or after the implementation date of the optional retirement plan at their institution or board will be effective as of the date of their employment. If an eligible employee fails to make the election provided for in this Section, he shall become a member of the regular retirement plan of the Teachers' Retirement System of Louisiana in accordance with R.S. 11:721.

7 B. Notwithstanding the provisions of Subsection A of this Section any 8 academic or administrative employee of a public postsecondary education institution 9 of higher education and any employee of the Board of Regents, Board of Trustees Supervisors for State Colleges and Universities the University of Louisiana System, 10 11 Board of Supervisors of Louisiana State University and Agricultural and Mechanical 12 College, and Board of Supervisors of Southern University and Agricultural and 13 Mechanical College, and Board of Supervisors of Community and Technical 14 Colleges, or their successors, and any other constitutionally established board which 15 manages public postsecondary education institutions of higher education who is an 16 active contributing member in the regular retirement plan of the Teachers' 17 Retirement System of Louisiana and who has less than five years of creditable 18 service in the Teachers' Retirement System of Louisiana, may make an irrevocable 19 election to participate in the optional retirement plan and transfer his accumulated 20 employee contributions to the optional retirement plan under the provisions of R.S. 21 11:926(A). The election provided by this Subsection can only be elected by a 22 member prior to attainment of five years of creditable service in the Teachers' 23 Retirement System of Louisiana.

24C. Any person who is an academic or administrative employee of a public25postsecondary education institution of higher education or employee of the Board of26Regents, Board of Trustees Supervisors for State Colleges and Universities the27University of Louisiana System, Board of Supervisors of Louisiana State University28and Agricultural and Mechanical College, or Board of Supervisors of Southern29University and Agricultural and Mechanical College, or Board of Supervisors of30Community and Technical Colleges, or their successors, and any other

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1	constitutionally established board which manages public postsecondary education
2	institutions of higher education who is not eligible for membership in the Teachers'
3	Retirement System of Louisiana because he is a part-time, seasonal, or temporary
4	employee as defined in 26 CFR 31:3121(b)(7)-2, or in any successor regulation, may
5	make an irrevocable election to participate in the optional retirement plan and
6	transfer any accumulated employee contributions to the optional retirement plan
7	under the provisions of R.S. 11:926(A).

15	(b) Beginning July 1, 2018, each constitutionally established board which
16	manages public postsecondary education institutions higher education board created
17	by Article VIII of the Constitution of Louisiana and each employer institution and
18	agency under its supervision and control shall contribute to the Teachers' Retirement
19	System of Louisiana on behalf of each participant in the optional retirement plan the
20	sum of:
21	* * *
22	(c)(i) Each board shall may establish by resolution an amount in excess of
23	the minimum required by Item (b)(ii) the amount provided pursuant to Items
24	(2)(a)(ii) or (b)(ii) of this Paragraph by resolution. The amount established shall be
25	the same for all employer institutions and agencies under each board's supervision
26	and control and shall be effective for an entire fiscal year.
27	(d) (ii) For fiscal year 2014-2015 2025-2026, each board shall submit to the
28	retirement system such resolution no later than July 15, 2014 2025, in order for an
29	amount established pursuant to this Subsection Subparagraph to become effective.
30	For each fiscal year thereafter, the system shall receive such resolution no later than

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June first in order for a new rate to become effective for the next fiscal year. If the 1 2 system does not receive a resolution containing a contribution amount by the 3 required deadline, the system shall apply the most recent contribution amount paid 4 by such board or employer institution or the minimum required by Subparagraph (b) 5 of this Paragraph, whichever is greater. 6 (e) (d) Upon receipt of this contribution, the Teachers' Retirement System 7 of Louisiana shall promptly pay over to the appropriate designated company or 8 companies an amount equal to the amount established by the applicable board 9 pursuant to Items (2)(a)(ii) or (b)(ii) Subparagraph (c) of this Paragraph or the 10 minimum required by Item (b)(ii) of this Paragraph, whichever is greater. 11 (f) (e) All amounts paid over to the appropriate designated company or 12 companies pursuant to this Paragraph shall be credited to the participant's contract 13 or contracts. The Teachers' Retirement System of Louisiana shall retain the balance 14 of this contribution for application to the unfunded accrued liability of the system. 15 (3)(a)Beginning July 1, 2014, for each employer that is not a 16 constitutionally established board which manages public postsecondary education 17 institutions higher education board created by Article VIII of the Constitution of 18 Louisiana or an employer institution under the supervision and control of such a 19 board, each such employer institution and board shall contribute to the Teachers' 20 Retirement System of Louisiana on behalf of each participant in the optional 21 retirement plan the sum greater of: 22 (i) The amount it would have contributed if the participant were a member

of the regular retirement plan of the Teachers' Retirement System of Louisiana
 pursuant to R.S. 11:102(D)(3) The amounts calculated pursuant to R.S.

(b) Upon receipt of this contribution, the Teachers' Retirement System of
Louisiana shall promptly pay over to the appropriate designated company or
companies an amount equal to: to the amount set forth in Item (a)(ii) of this

2	(i) The employer's portion of the normal cost contribution as determined
3	annually by the Public Retirement Systems' Actuarial Committee if payment is
4	remitted pursuant to Item (3)(a)(i) of this Paragraph.
5	(ii) Six and two-tenths percent of pay if payment is remitted pursuant to Item
6	(3)(a)(ii) of this Paragraph.

8	§928. Limitations
9	Any Except as provided in R.S. 11:932, any person electing to participate in
10	the optional retirement plan shall always be ineligible for membership in the regular
11	retirement plan of the Teachers' Retirement System of Louisiana even if he is
12	employed in a position covered by the Teachers' Retirement System of Louisiana.
13	If an optional retirement plan participant assumes a position other than as an
14	employee of a public postsecondary education institution of higher education or
15	employee of the Board of Regents, Board of Trustees Supervisors for State Colleges
16	and Universities the University of Louisiana System, Board of Supervisors of
17	Louisiana State University and Agricultural and Mechanical College, or Board of
18	Supervisors of Southern University and Agricultural and Mechanical College, or
19	Board of Supervisors of Community and Technical Colleges, or their successors, and
20	any other constitutionally established board which manages public postsecondary
21	education institutions of higher education in a position covered by the Teachers'
22	Retirement System of Louisiana, he shall continue to participate in the optional
23	retirement plan. If an optional retirement plan participant assumes a position in state
24	service other than as an employee of a public <u>postsecondary education</u> institution of
25	higher education or employee of the Board of Regents, Board of Trustees
26	Supervisors for State Colleges and Universities the University of Louisiana System,
27	Board of Supervisors of Louisiana State University and Agricultural and Mechanical
28	College, or Board of Supervisors of Southern University and Agricultural and
29	Mechanical College, or Board of Supervisors of Community and Technical Colleges,
30	or their successors, and any other constitutionally established board which manages

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1	public postsecondary education institutions of higher education in a position not
2	
	covered by the Teachers' Retirement System of Louisiana, he must at that time begin
3	membership in the appropriate retirement system which provides benefits for that
4	position in state service, other than the Teachers' Retirement System of Louisiana.

6	§931. Implementation
7	A. The Board of Trustees of the Teachers' Retirement System of Louisiana
8	shall implement the optional retirement plan no later than March 1, 1990, and the
9	public institutions of higher education shall implement their optional retirement
10	plans on July 1, 1990.
11	<u>B.</u> The Board of Regents, Board of Trustees Supervisors for State Colleges
12	and Universities the University of Louisiana System, Board of Supervisors of
13	Louisiana State University and Agricultural and Mechanical College, and Board of
14	Supervisors of Southern University and Agricultural and Mechanical College, and
15	Board of Supervisors of Community and Technical Colleges, or their successors, and
16	any other constitutionally established board which manages institutions of higher
17	education shall implement their optional retirement plans no later than July 1, 1998.
18	C. All public postsecondary education institutions not covered by
19	Subsection A or B of this Section shall implement their optional retirement plans no
20	later than July 1, 2025.
21	§932. Regular plan membership; irrevocable election
22	* * *
23	B.(1) Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, any participant
24	in the optional retirement plan whose first employment making him eligible for
25	participation in the optional retirement plan occurred on or before July 31, 2020, who
26	was not an actively employed participant in the optional retirement plan on June 30,
27	2024, and who, notwithstanding his participation in the optional retirement plan, is
28	employed on or after July 1, 2024, in a position that would otherwise make such
29	participant eligible for membership in the regular retirement plan of the Teachers'
30	Retirement System of Louisiana, may make an irrevocable election to become a

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1	member of the regular retirement plan of the Teachers' Retirement System of
2	Louisiana. The election shall be made in writing in a manner prescribed by the
3	system and received by the system by the later of:
4	(a) September 2, 2025.
5	(b) Sixty days after the date of the participant's first employment occurring
6	on or after July 1, 2024, in a position that would otherwise make him eligible for
7	membership in the regular retirement plan of the Teachers' Retirement System of
8	Louisiana.
9	(2) For a participant making the election, all contributions to the optional
10	retirement plan from the participant and from his employer shall cease on the last
11	day of the month following the month in which the system receives the election.
12	Beginning on the first day of the following month, the participant shall begin
13	contributing to and accruing benefits in the regular retirement plan of the Teachers'
14	Retirement System of Louisiana as a member first eligible for membership in a state
15	system on that date. The person's employing agency shall pay the system the
16	contributions required pursuant to R.S. 11:102.
17	$\underline{C.(1)}$ Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, any active
18	contributing participant in the optional retirement plan whose first employment

contributing participant in the optional retirement plan whose first employment 18 19 making him eligible for participation in the optional retirement plan occurred on or 20 after August 1, 2020, and who, notwithstanding participation in the optional 21 retirement plan, is otherwise eligible for membership in the regular retirement plan 22 of the Teachers' Retirement System of Louisiana may make an irrevocable election 23 to become a member of the regular retirement plan of the Teachers' Retirement 24 System of Louisiana. The election shall be made in writing in a manner prescribed 25 by the system and shall be received by the retirement system within five seven years 26 of the participant's first employment making him eligible for participation in the 27 optional retirement plan.

(2) For a participant making the election, all contributions to the optional
 retirement plan from the participant and from his employer shall cease on the last
 day of the month following the month in which the system receives the election.

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1	Beginning on the first day of the following month, the participant shall begin
2	contributing to and accruing benefits in the regular retirement plan of the Teachers'
3	Retirement System of Louisiana as a member first eligible for membership in a state
4	system on that date. The person's employing agency shall pay the system the
5	contributions required <u>pursuant</u> to R.S. 11:102.
6	C. D. Any and all distributions from the optional retirement plan to a
7	participant who made the election provided for in this Section shall be in accordance
8	with R.S. 11:929.
9	\overline{D} . <u>E</u> . If any participant making an election to become a member of the
10	regular retirement plan of the Teachers' Retirement System of Louisiana has, at the
11	time of such election, prior service in the regular retirement plan, the prior service
12	shall be used for calculation of benefits only and shall not be used to attain eligibility
13	for any purpose, including but not limited to retirement, disability, or survivor
14	benefits.
15	§933. Optional Retirement Plan Advisory Committee
16	A. There is hereby established an advisory committee, to be known as the
17	Optional Retirement Plan Advisory Committee.
18	B. The advisory committee shall be comprised of the following members:
19	(1) The president of each constitutionally established board which manages
20	public postsecondary education institutions shall select one faculty member from
21	among the faculty members of the institutions under the management of the board
22	to be a member of the advisory committee. The person selected shall be a participant
23	in the optional retirement plan established by R.S. 11:921, et seq.
24	(2) The president of each constitutionally established board which manages
25	public postsecondary education institutions shall select one nonfaculty unclassified
26	staff member from among the nonfaculty unclassified staff members of the
27	institutions under the management of the board to be a member of the advisory
28	committee. The person selected shall be a participant in the optional retirement plan
29	established by R.S. 11:921, et seq.
30	(3) The commissioner of higher education shall select one member to

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1	represent participants in the optional retirement plan who are not employed by a
2	public postsecondary education institution. The person selected shall be a
3	participant in the optional retirement plan established by R.S. 11:921, et seq.
4	C. Members shall serve without compensation but may be reimbursed for
5	expenses as provided by the appointing authority.
6	D. The advisory committee shall:
7	(1) Provide information and feedback to the Board of Trustees for the
8	Teachers' Retirement System of Louisiana related to:
9	(a) Optional Retirement Plan terms.
10	(b) Vendor selection.
11	(c) Administrative fees.
12	(d) Investments.
13	(2) Provide regular updates to optional retirement plan participants.
14	E. Each entity represented by a member of the advisory committee shall
15	provide clerical staff and clerical support as requested by the advisory committee in
16	fulfillment of the duties of the advisory committee.
17	Section 2. R.S. 11:927(B)(2)(f) is hereby repealed in its entirety.
18	Section 3. The cost of this Act, if any, shall be funded with additional employer
19	contributions in compliance with Article X, Section 29(F) of the Constitution of Louisiana.
20	Section 4. This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2025.
