15 "PART III. SOLAR POWER GENERATION FACILITIES

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- 17 <u>§1142</u>. Jurisdiction; authority of the department, local governing authorities
- A. The secretary of the Department of Energy and Natural Resources shall have jurisdiction over all persons and property, and shall have the authority to perform all acts
- 20 <u>necessary to enforce the provisions of this Part and any rules adopted pursuant to this Part.</u>
- B. Any parish that has adopted solar ordinances may by resolution opt out of the siting requirements of this Part. Upon submission of such resolution so passed to the
- department, the siting standards of this Part shall not apply to that parish.
- 24 §1143. Permitting
- A. No person shall construct, install, or operate a solar power generation facility
- 26 with a footprint of seventy-five or more acres without holding a permit issued by the
- 27 <u>department pursuant to this Part.</u>
- 28 B. The Department of Agriculture and Forestry and the Department of Wildlife and
- 29 <u>Fisheries may submit comments regarding construction, installation, and operation of any</u>
- 30 power generation facility to the department.
- 31 §1144. Facility siting
- A. Any solar power generation facility with a footprint of seventy-five acres or more which is not located wholly within an industrial-zoned area or a Louisiana Economic
- Development certified site shall comply with the standards set forth in this Section.
- B. There shall be a buffer around the perimeter of each solar power generation
- 36 <u>facility that includes setbacks and a vegetative barrier to screen the facility from view. The</u>
- 37 vegetative barrier shall be comprised of native vegetation, shall ensure an opaque visual
- 38 <u>barrier year round, and shall be designed to conceal the development from view from</u>
- adjoining properties. Stamped landscape plans by a licensed landscape architect or
- 40 <u>landscape horticulturalist shall be required for permitting. Existing vegetation on-site may</u>
- 41 be retained undisturbed in satisfaction of the vegetative barrier requirement if it otherwise
- 42 <u>meets the requirements of this Section.</u>

(1) For residential property, unless provided otherwise by written agreement
between the property owner and the facility operator, there shall be a three hundred foot
setback from the residential property line to the nearest solar device, with one of the
following:

- (a) A thirty-five foot deep vegetative barrier composed of new plant material.
- (b) A fifty foot deep vegetative barrier composed of natural plant material.
- (2) For natural and navigable water bodies, there shall be a one hundred foot setback from the ordinary low water mark to the nearest solar device.
- (3) For public roads, there shall be a fifty foot setback from the edge of the paved road surface to the nearest solar device, with a thirty-five vegetative barrier.
- C. Noise levels at the property line of the facility shall not exceed ten A-weighted decibels (dbA) above the ambient noise level present at the property line prior to operation of the facility.
- D. The provisions of this Section shall apply to any solar power generation facility for which construction begins after January 1, 2026.
- 16 §1145. Prohibitions

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Any chemical that is not approved for agricultural application shall not be sprayed for maintenance of a solar power generation facility site."
