CONDOLENCES. Expresses sincere and heartfelt condolences to the family and friends of Phil Alexander Robertson on the occasion of his passing.

1 A RESOLUTION 2 To express sincere and heartfelt condolences of the Senate of the Legislature of Louisiana to the family and friends of Phil Robertson on the occasion of his passing. 3 4 WHEREAS, it is with immense sadness and profound sorrow that we have learned 5 of the passing of Phil Alexander Robertson on May 25, 2025; and 6 WHEREAS, born the fifth of seven children on April 24, 1946, to Merritt and James 7 Robertson in Vivian, Louisiana, Phil's life was defined by hard work, redemption, deep 8 Christian faith, and unshakable family values; and 9 WHEREAS, the Robertson family lived in rugged conditions, having no electricity, 10 toilet, or bathtub and rarely ventured into town to buy groceries choosing instead to live off 11 the fruits and vegetables grown in their garden; meat from deer, squirrel, fish, and other game they hunted and fished; and the pigs, chickens, and cattle that they raised; and as Phil 12 13 recalled "It was the 1950s when I was a young boy, but we lived like it was the 1850s, but we were always happy, happy no matter the circumstances"; and 14 WHEREAS, in 1966 Phil married his high school sweetheart, Marsha "Miss Kay" 15 Carroway, whom he had been dating since 1964 and started a family in Ruston, Louisiana 16 where Phil's high school athletic ability winning all-state honors in football, baseball, and 17 18 track afforded him the opportunity to attend Louisiana Tech on a football scholarship in the

1	late 1960's; playing first string quarterback for the Bulldogs ahead of Pro Foot Hall of Famer
2	Terry Bradshaw; and
3	WHEREAS, although his love of hunting took precedence over football as it took
4	time away from hunting season, Phil maintained his studies eventually earning a bachelor's
5	degree is physical education and a master's degree in education; and
6	WHEREAS, as a young man, he struggled to gain control of his life but with the
7	support of "Miss Kay" and his sister, Jan, he found the love of Christ and never turned back;
8	devoting his life to Jesus at the age of twenty-eight he began a life and career around the
9	things he cherished most: hunting, family, and faith; and
10	WHEREAS, Phil Robertson had a desire to assist souls to find God's love, baptizing
11	many, inspiring thousands, with a spiritual transformation which impacted not only his life
12	but that of his family and others; and
13	WHEREAS, being an avid duck hunter, Phil became dissatisfied with the existing
14	duck calls on the market and experimented with them, attempting to produce the exact sound
15	of a duck, which led him to develop the "Duck Commander", a double-reeded duck call in
16	1972, finally receiving a patent and establishing Duck Commander Inc. in 1973; which grew
17	into a multimillion-dollar family business now headed by his son, Willie Robertson, with a
18	motto of "Faith, Family, Ducks"; and
19	WHEREAS, from 2012 to 2017, Phil as the Robertson Family Patriarch and his wife,
20	"Miss Kay", were portrayed on the hit reality television series "Duck Dynasty" which
21	regularly featured his sons, Alan, Jase, Willie, and Jep and Phil's brother, Si; and
22	WHEREAS, Phil Robertson, through his personality and Duck Commander brand
23	is responsible for an immensely positive economic impact on northeast Louisiana and the
24	entire state; and
25	WHEREAS, widely admired as a man of strong faith and conviction forged through
26	experiences, high and low, with devotion to family and authenticity in an increasingly
27	complex world, Phil embodied the American spirit of perseverance, independence, and
28	purpose while navigating the challenges of fame and public life; and
29	WHEREAS, through humble beginnings, intelligence, deep connection to the

outdoors, dedication to his Christian faith, family values, and conservative ideals, Phil

inspired countless Americans with his example, candor, and ability to remain true to himself as he navigated through new-found challenges of fame and public life, and became an inspiration to all; and
