CIVIL/LAW: Provides relative to the freedom to display the flag of the United States.

DIGEST

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that no planned community, condominium association, or lessor shall adopt or enforce any provision outlawing or restricting an individual from displaying a removable, portable flag of the United States.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that nothing in <u>proposed law</u> shall prevent a planned community, condominium association, or lessor from adopting or enforcing reasonable provisions as to the size, time, place, and manner of displaying the flag of the United States.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides for injunctive relief, court costs, and reasonable attorney fees when a violation of <u>proposed law</u> occurs.
