SUMMARY OF HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO THE SENATE BILL

- 1. Adds a requirement for the assessment of persons willing to seek voluntary admission upon arrival at the treating facility.
- 2. Makes technical changes.

DIGEST OF THE SENATE BILL AS RETURNED TO THE SENATE

SB 120 Engrossed 2025 Regular Session

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<u>Present law</u> provides for admission by emergency certificate for individuals in need of immediate care and treatment in a treatment facility by a medical provider that has determined that the individual is dangerous to himself or others or is gravely disabled.

<u>Present law</u> requires the medical provider executing the emergency certificate to attest that the person is unwilling or unable to seek voluntary admission.

<u>Proposed law</u> adds a provision to the certificate that the person is willing to seek voluntary admission upon arrival at the treating facility.

<u>Proposed law</u> adds a requirement for the assessment of persons willing to seek voluntary admission upon arrival at the treating facility.

Effective August 1, 2025.
