<u>Proposed law</u> authorizes a pharmacist to dispense ivermectin to a person 18 or older pursuant to a standing order issued by a healthcare professional with prescriptive authority in the La. Dept. of Health (LDH).

<u>Proposed law</u> requires LDH to adopt rules to establish procedures for dispensing ivermectin.

<u>Proposed law</u> authorizes a pharmacy to charge an administrative fee for any services required by proposed law in addition to the ingredient cost and dispensing fee.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides for civil immunity for pharmacists dispensing ivermectin in accordance with <u>proposed law</u>.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that a health insurance issuer is not required to provide coverage for the cost of ivermectin dispensed pursuant to proposed law.

Effective August 1, 2025.
