INSURANCE/HEALTH: Requires health insurance coverage for histotripsy procedures.

DIGEST

<u>Proposed law</u> creates an advisory board within the Department of Insurance to review and make medical recommendations to approve new treatments for certain cancers.

Proposed law provides for the composition of the board.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides for the chair of the board.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides for quarterly meetings of the board. <u>Proposed law</u> further provides for a written report of its findings submitted by the board to the legislature within 30 days of each meeting.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides the commissioner with rulemaking authority.

Effective August 1, 2025.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

The Committee Amendments Proposed by <u>House Committee on Insurance</u> to the <u>original</u> bill:

- 1. Require patients to meet any one of certain conditions for treatment eligibility.
- 2. Apply <u>proposed law</u> to Medicaid enrollees who meet conditions for treatment and require Medicare provider organizations to provide certain documentation to LDH.
- 3. Apply <u>proposed law</u> to new policies, contracts, or plans issued on and after Jan. 1, 2026. Require existing policies, contracts, or plans to conform with <u>proposed</u> law by Jan. 1, 2027.
