HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 1

BY REPRESENTATIVE MCMAKIN

A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

To repeal the Department of State rule (LAC 31:III.303(B)(1)(j)), which provides relative

to password protection and authentication on devices used for tabulation as part of

a voting system to be tested and certified for use in Louisiana, and to direct the office

of the state register to incorporate the repeal into the Louisiana Administrative Code.

WHEREAS, LAC 31:III.303(B)(1)(j) requires any new voting system to be tested

and certified for use in Louisiana to provide password protection and multi-factor user

authentication on every device used for tabulation; and

WHEREAS, R.S. 49:969 provides that the legislature, by concurrent resolution, may

suspend, amend, or repeal any rule adopted by a state department, agency, board, or

commission.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Legislature of Louisiana that LAC

31:III.303(B)(1)(j) is hereby repealed in its entirety.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution be transmitted to the

office of the state register.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the office of the state register is hereby directed

to have the repeal of LAC 31:III.303(B)(1)(j) incorporated into the Louisiana Administrative

Code.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution shall become effective on June

12, 2025.
