#### SENATE BILL NO. 85

### BY SENATOR WHEAT AND REPRESENTATIVE THOMPSON

Prefiled pursuant to Article III, Section 2(A)(4)(b)(i) of the Constitution of Louisiana.

1	AN ACT
2	To amend and reenact R.S. 34:851.4(A)(17), 851.14.1(A), 851.27(B)(1) and (3) and (C), and
3	R.S. 38:3086.24(F)(2)(a) and to enact R.S. 34:851.27(B)(10), relative to operation
4	of watercraft; to provide for requirements of careless operation; to provide for
5	emergency closure of waterways; to provide for parish authority, to provide for
6	posting of no-wake zones, to provide for state authority, to provide for enforcement,
7	to provide for powers of the Bayou Lafourche Fresh Water District; and to provide
8	for related matters.
9	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
10	Section 1. R.S. 34:851.4(A)(17), 851.14.1(A), and 851.27(B)(1) and (3) and (C) are
11	hereby amended and reenacted and R.S. 34:851.27(B)(10) is hereby enacted to read as
12	follows:
13	§851.4. Careless operation of a watercraft
14	A. Careless operation of a watercraft is the operation of a watercraft in a
15	careless manner so as to endanger the life, limb, or property of any person, when
16	such operation constitutes a violation of any of the following requirements:

18	(17) No person shall, under any circumstances, operate a vessel in excess of
19	an established speed or wake <b><u>no-wake</u></b> zone.

21	§851.14.1. Closure of waterways
22	A. In an emergency or disaster, as defined in R.S. 29:723, the secretary may
23	close any waterway, other than navigable waters of the United States as set forth in
24	33 CFR Part 2, to boating access, travel, or use or may restrict the type of use
25	including issuing no wake no-wake zones in any reasonable manner. Such closure

1	or restriction shall be for a period of time not to extend beyond the seventh day
2	following the next meeting of the Wildlife and Fisheries Commission.

4	§851.27. Local regulations prohibited; exceptions; speed limits; no-wake zones
5	* * *
6	B.(1) The governing authority of any parish or municipality may establish
7	and post speed limits and no-wake zones on waterways within its jurisdiction with
8	the exception of the Mississippi River, the Mississippi River Gulf Outlet, and the
9	Gulf Intracoastal Waterway. Such speed limits and no-wake zones, if established,
10	shall be posted along the affected waterway. A no-wake zone established under
11	this Paragraph shall not extend beyond three hundred feet from any physical
12	structure situated along the banks. Any no-wake zone established under this
13	Paragraph that affects the entire width of a waterway shall not exceed one mile
14	in length.
15	* * *
16	(3) Speed limits <b>and no-wake zones</b> established under this Section shall be
17	enforced by the sheriffs, local law enforcement officers, state police and by
18	permanent status wildlife agents and duly commissioned wildlife agents and officers
19	who shall have the power to make arrests for purposes of such enforcement.
20	* * *
21	(10) No state law, rule, or regulation establishing, limiting, or prohibiting
22	no-wake zones shall be preempted by a no-wake zone established by the
23	governing authority of a parish or municipality under the provisions of this
24	Section.
25	C. In addition to speed limits and no-wake zones established by any
26	governing authority of any parish or municipality under the provisions of this
27	Section, there are hereby established certain "no-wake" no-wake zones where each
28	vessel shall operate at bare steerage speed, the slowest speed the vessel can travel
29	while allowing the operator to maintain directional control of the vessel to produce
30	the minimum water surface turbulence. The "no-wake" no-wake zones are

6	Section 2. R.S. 38:3086.24(F)(2)(a) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as
7	follows:
8	§3086.24. Powers
9	* * *
10	F.(1) In order to accomplish the purposes of the district, the board may make
11	and enforce such rules, regulations, and ordinances it shall deem necessary:
12	* * *
13	(2) Notwithstanding R.S. 34:851.27 or any other provision of law to the
14	contrary, and upon a declaration of an emergency by the board that the size and
15	speed of watercraft traveling through the waterway needs to be regulated to protect
16	the integrity of the banks of the waterway due to low water levels or due to another
17	event causing the banks to be in peril of erosion or instability, the board may:
18	(a) Implement and enforce a <del>"no-wake" <u>no-wake</u> zone where each watercraft</del>
19	shall operate at bare steerage speed, the slowest speed the watercraft can travel while
20	allowing the operator to maintain directional control of the watercraft to produce the
21	minimum water surface turbulence.
