<u>Existing law</u> establishes classes of permits for construction on certain water bodies and provides for their issuance by the state land office. Construction of a bulkhead or flood protection structure in proximity to the bank or shore requires a Class B Permit.

Existing law requires a coastal use permit for certain uses of lands in the coastal zone, and provides for issuance of such permits by the Dept. of Energy and Natural Resources.

<u>New law</u> prohibits the issuance of Class B Permits from March 17, 2025, to January 1, 2030, for bulkhead construction in St. Tammany Parish within a defined area that includes Lake Emfred and Suter Slip.

<u>New law</u> prohibits the issuance of coastal use permits from March 17, 2025, to January 1, 2030, for bulkhead construction in the same designated area.

Effective June 8, 2025.
