<u>Prior law</u> defined "drug paraphernalia" but excluded rapid fentanyl test strips or any testing equipment or devices solely used, intended for use, or designed to determine whether a substance contains fentanyl or its analogues.

<u>New law</u> expands the <u>prior law</u> exemption <u>from</u> testing only for fentanyl or its analogues <u>to</u> testing for any controlled dangerous substance or chemical compound that can cause physical harm or death, provided that the testing equipment is not used to facilitate the unlawful manufacture or distribution of any controlled dangerous substance.
