Existing law provides for the crimes of cruelty to persons with infirmities and exploitation of persons with infirmities. Existing law includes persons who are aged.

New law changes the term "aged" to "elderly".

New law adds financial exploitation to the crime of exploitation of elderly persons or persons with infirmities.

New law provides penalties for a second conviction of exploitation of elderly persons or persons with infirmities.

New law provides that a person convicted of exploitation of elderly persons or persons with infirmities shall make full restitution to the victim and anyone else who suffered a financial loss.

Effective August 1, 2025.
