ACT 427 (SB 130)

2025 Regular Session

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New law provides legislative intent regarding the integrity of the Medicaid program.

New law requires the La. Dept. of Health to implement certain program integrity measures to verify ongoing Medicaid eligibility, including checking information provided by other state agencies.

New law prohibits the La. Dept. of Health from accepting eligibility from certain exchanges established by federal law, relying solely on ex parte renewals, or accepting self-attestation of Louisiana residency.

New law authorizes the La. Dept of Health to use technology and government data sharing to verify income, residency, household composition, or receipt of other coverage.

New law authorizes the La. Dept. of Health to use an enhanced verification platform to verify recipient eligibility.

New law requires the La. Dept. of Health to make certain noncompliance and fraud information available to the public on its website.

Effective June 20, 2025.
