<u>Existing law</u> provides that illegal carrying of weapons includes the intentional possession or use by any person of a dangerous weapon on a school campus during regular school hours or on a school bus. <u>Existing law</u> defines "school" as any elementary, secondary, high school, or vo-tech school.

<u>New law</u> provides that the definition of "school" does not include a privately owned vocational-technical school. <u>New law</u> otherwise retains <u>existing law</u>.

<u>Existing law</u> provides that illegal carrying of weapons includes the intentional concealment of any firearm, or other instrumentality customarily used or intended for probable use as a dangerous weapon, on one's person, and provides an exception for a person with a valid concealed handgun permit issued pursuant to <u>existing law</u>. <u>Existing law</u> further provides an exception for a person who is 18 years of age and not prohibited from possessing a firearm under state or federal law.

<u>New law</u> makes a technical change to <u>existing law</u> but otherwise retains <u>existing law</u>.

<u>Existing law</u> prohibits carrying a firearm or other dangerous weapon by a student or nonstudent on school property, at a school sponsored function, or in a firearm-free zone at any time while on a school campus, on school transportation, or at any school sponsored function in a specific designated area including but not limited to an athletic competition, dances, parties, or any extracurricular activities, or within 1,000 feet of any school campus.

<u>New law provides that existing law</u> does not apply to a person who has a concealed handgun permit issued by a state that has reciprocity with La. for the lawful concealed carry of a handgun or to a person carrying a handgun pursuant to other <u>existing law</u>.

Existing law defines "school" as any elementary, secondary, high school, vocational-technical school, college or university.

<u>New law</u> provides that the definition of "school" does not include a privately owned vocational-technical school. <u>New law</u> otherwise retains <u>existing law</u>.
