## ACT 242 (HB 120) 2025 Regular Session

Existing law (R.S. 29:3) provides for a state militia comprised of the organized militia consisting of the national guard, the La. State Guard, and other organized military forces which may be authorized by law, and also consisting of the unorganized militia consisting of all other persons subject to military duty.

Existing law provides for death and disability benefits for La. National Guardsmen called to active duty service by the governor or the president of the U.S.

<u>New law</u> provides for death and disability benefits for La. State Guardsmen called to active duty service by the governor or the president of the U.S.

Existing law prohibits discrimination in employment against members of the La. National Guardsmen.

<u>New law</u> extends <u>existing law</u> to La. State Guardsmen.

Existing law provides that no student member of the uniformed services of the U.S. shall have his postsecondary education, including but not limited to colleges and universities, unnecessarily disrupted because of his military service.

<u>New law</u> extends the academic protections to La. State Guardsmen.

Effective August 1, 2025.
