# 1 AN ACT

2 To amend and reenact R.S. 33:9038.69(B), relative to the city of Monroe; to provide relative  
3 to the Walnut Street Special District; to provide relative to the boundaries of the  
4 district; and to provide for related matters.

8 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

9           Section 1. R.S. 33:9038.69(B) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:  
10           §9038.69. Walnut Street Special District

12                   B. Boundaries. (1) The district shall be comprised of the area of the city of  
13                   Monroe in the blocks of 108-128 Walnut Street in the city of Monroe to Art Alley  
14                   (2nd Street), an area of approximately one city block which shall be further defined  
15                   by an ordinance of the board of commissioners of the district.

**Abstract:** Makes changes to the boundaries of the Walnut Street Special District in the city of Monroe.

Present law creates the Walnut Street Special District in the city of Monroe as a special district and political subdivision of the state to provide for cooperative economic development between the district, the city of Monroe, and the owner or owners of businesses and other property within the district in order to provide for costs related to infrastructure within the district as determined by the board of commissioners of the district. Provides for the governance and powers and duties of the district.

Proposed law retains present law.

Present law provides for the district's boundaries.

Proposed law expands the district's boundaries.
