Abstract: Provides relative to the boundaries and parcel fee of the Victoria Farms Crime Prevention and Improvement District in East Baton Rouge Parish.

Present law creates the Victoria Farms Crime Prevention and Improvement District in East Baton Rouge Parish as a political subdivision of the state for the purpose of aiding in crime prevention and providing for the overall betterment of the district. Provides for the governance and powers and duties of the district.

Present law provides for the boundaries of the district.

Proposed law makes changes to the district's boundaries.

Proposed law authorizes the district, subject to voter approval, to impose and collect a parcel fee on each improved and unimproved parcel within the district. Provides that the amount of the fee shall be in a duly adopted resolution of the board and shall not exceed \$100 per parcel per year.

Proposed law retains present law and additionally authorizes the district's governing board to change the amount of the fee by duly adopted resolution of the board, without election, not to exceed the maximum amount.

Effective upon signature of governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
