(Constitutional Amendment) Provides relative to parental rights

Proposed constitutional amendment adds the fundamental right of parents to decide the nurturing, education, care, custody, and control of their children; provides that any denial, infringement, or restriction of these rights be subject to strict scrutiny unless there is a higher level of protection recognized by the court.

To be submitted to the electors at the statewide election to be held on November 3, 2026.
