Seabaugh

Present law provides that an insurance contract issued in Louisiana may limit the right of action against the insurer to a period of not less than 24 months from the date of the inception of a loss.

Proposed law retains present law.

Proposed law provides that any payment made by the insurer pursuant to the term of its contract will not serve as an acknowledgment of a debt or otherwise interrupt the prescriptive period.

Effective August 1, 2026.
