Present law requires each public school governing authority to install cameras in certain classrooms and to adopt policies that include provisions for determining to whom and under what circumstances the video and audio recordings may be disclosed.

Proposed law retains present law and further requires both the superintendent and his designee or two designees of the superintendent be present during the initial viewing of the recordings after a request has been made.

Effective August 1, 2026.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by Senate

Committee Amendments Proposed by Senate Committee on Education to the original bill

1. Changes the required people present during the initial viewing of recordings from the superintendent or his designee and the parent or legal guardian to the superintendent and his designee or two designees of the superintendent.
