
HOUSE COMMITTEE AMENDMENTS

2026 Regular Session

Amendments proposed by House Committee on Insurance to Original House Bill No. 920
by Representative Jordan

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 6, after "coverage;" and before "and" insert the following:

3 "to provide for retroactive application; to provide for an effective date;"

4 AMENDMENT NO. 2

5 On page 2, between lines 8 and 9, insert the following:

6 "(3) A health coverage plan renewed, delivered, or issued for delivery in this state
7 shall not deny coverage for GLP-1 medications if all of the following apply:8 (a) The GLP-1 medication has been approved by the United States Food and Drug
9 Administration regardless of the insured's specific medical condition or diagnosis.10 (b) The GLP-1 medication is prescribed by a licensed healthcare provider.11 (c) The GLP-1 medication is on the insurer's formulary or preferred drug list, if
12 applicable.13 (4) The GLP-1 medication may be subject to annual deductibles, coinsurance, and
14 copayment provisions as are consistent with those established under the health coverage
15 plan.16 (5) A health coverage plan shall pay twenty-five percent of the cost of covered GLP-
17 1 medications after all discounts and policy benefits are applied when prescribed by a
18 licensed healthcare provider, regardless of the medication's form."19 AMENDMENT NO. 3

20 On page 2, after line 18, add the following:

21 "Section 3. This Act shall apply to any new policy, contract, program, or health
22 coverage plan issued on and after January 1, 2026. Any policy, contract, or health coverage
23 plan in effect prior to January 1, 2026, shall convert to conform to this Act on or before the
24 renewal date, but no later than January 1, 2027.25 Section 4. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
26 signed by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of
27 Louisiana. If vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by this legislature, this Act
28 shall become effective on the day following such approval."
