Provides for the online publication and maintenance of certain data used and compiled by the DPS&C

Proposed law provides for legislative findings; provides that no later than 30 days after the end of each calendar month, DPS&C shall publish on its publicly accessible website a downloadable, machine-readable version of the offender census at state correctional facilities; provides that DPS&C shall publish on its website, in Microsoft Excel format, all underlying datasets used to generate each informational dashboard including certain demographic information; provides that DPS&C shall publish and maintain on its website a publicly accessible index of correctional datasets maintained by the department, including the name of each dataset, a general description, data range available, frequency of update, whether the dataset is available for download, and contact information for public records requests; provides that it shall not require the disclosure of personally identifiable information protected under state or federal law and that the department may redact identifying information necessary to comply with applicable confidentiality provisions; provides that Corrections shall update datasets on an annual basis; provides that DPS&C shall submit a written report certifying compliance with the proposed law to the House Committee on the Administration of Criminal Justice and the Senate Committee on Judiciary B, no later than 3/31/27; provides that DPS&C shall implement the proposed law no later than 10/01/26.
