**Abstract:** Increases the maximum fine imposed for violations of parish ordinances from \$500 to \$1,500.

Present law provides that the maximum penalty that may be imposed for the violation of a parish ordinance is a \$500 fine and imprisonment of 30 days in the parish jail.

Proposed law provides for an increase of the maximum fine that may be imposed for the violation of a parish ordinance from \$500 to \$1,500.

Present law provides that the maximum penalty that may be imposed for violation of any parish ordinance as codified in Title 11 or 13 of the Code of Ordinances for the parish of East Baton Rouge and the city of Baton Rouge is \$1,000 and imprisonment of six months in the parish jail.

Proposed law provides for an increase of the maximum fine that may be imposed for the violation of a parish ordinance in East Baton Rouge and the city of Baton Rouge from \$1,000 to \$1,500.

Present law provides that in Jefferson Parish, except as to properties zoned or used for industrial activities, the maximum penalty which may be imposed for violation of any parish ordinance is \$1,000 and imprisonment of six months in the parish jail.

Proposed law provides for an increase of the maximum fine that may be imposed for violation of any parish ordinance in Jefferson Parish from \$1,000 to \$1,500.

Proposed law otherwise retains present law.

### Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

#### The House Floor Amendments to the engrossed bill:

1. Increase the maximum fine which may be imposed for violation of any parish ordinance as codified in Title 11 or 13 of the Code of Ordinance for the parish of East Baton Rouge and the city of Baton Rouge from \$1,000 to \$1,500.

2. Increase the maximum fine which may be imposed for violation of any parish ordinance in Jefferson Parish from \$1,000 to \$1,500.
