Abstract: Increases penalties and adds a restitution clause to the crimes of desecration of graves and institutional vandalism.

Present law (R.S. 14:101) provides a penalty of not more than a \$500 fine and up to six months imprisonment for desecration of graves.

Proposed law increases the fine for desecration of graves from not more than \$500 to not more than \$1,000 and requires the offender to make restitution for damages.

Present law (R.S. 14:225) provides the following penalties for institutional vandalism:

- (1) When damage is less than \$500, a fine of up to \$500 or up to six months imprisonment, or both.
- (2) When damage is more than \$500 but less than \$50,000, a fine of not more than \$1,000 or imprisonment with or without hard labor not more than two years.

Proposed law increases the fine for damage less than \$500 from \$500 to \$1,000.

Proposed law increases the fine for damage between \$500 and \$50,000 from not more than \$1,000 to not less than \$1,000 nor more than \$5,000.

Proposed law requires the offender to make restitution when institutional vandalism is committed against a religious building.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

The House Floor Amendments to the engrossed bill:

1. Require additional restitution in accordance with present law (C.Cr.P. Art. 883.2).
